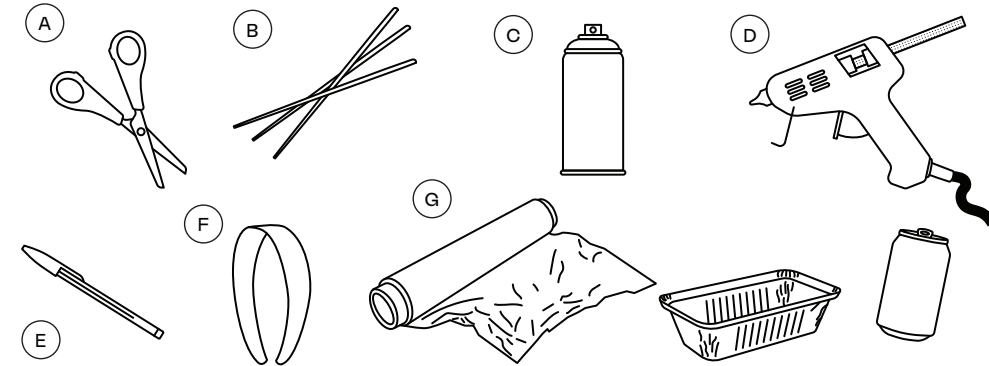

A few simples steps Head Piece

of the techniques mentioned below.



1 Cut out petals

Our head piece is based on the shape
of a flower called the 'lotus flower'.
This was the main piece of inspiration
for metalworking during the Iron Age.

Cut out 4 small petal shapes and 1 large petal
from the foil containers.

2 Spray the skewers

Spray paint the skewers gold and once dry,
use the hot glue gun to attach the skewers to
the head band.

3 Repoussé

Using the Repoussé technique we learned
earlier, decorate the foil petals using some
of the La Tené motifs with a pen.

4 Glue gun at the ready

Using the hot glue gun attach the metals to
the top of the head piece. Becareful of the
hot glue!!

5 Add foil balls

Roll up some balls of different sizes from tin
foil and attach them to the head band covering
up the entire visible surface of the head band.

6 Flower power

Make some flowers from the tinfoil and spray
paint them gold. Once dry attach to the head
piece. Boom! You have your very own crown.
