1 Plan your carton

Quickly sketch up some ideas and decide what type of character your carton should be. This one wants to be a corpse bride, inspired by the artist and filmmaker Tim Burton.

2 Let it see

Stick your googly eyes into the lids and then place them onto the jug. Use a permanent marker to draw on the facial features such as eyebrows, nose and cheek bones.

3 Make a mouth

Be very careful with the scissors and hot glue. Ask an adult for help if you need it.

On a waste piece of plastic, draw a mouth with a permanent marker, preferably red in colour. Cut out the lips when you are happy and glue them in place on the carton.

4 Add accessories

Roll up some netting from fruit/veg as hair for the carton character. Next glue some lids to side of the head for ears.

5 Brides veil

Cut a rectangle of mesh 30cm x 60cm, one edge with a curve, the other with a zig-zag pattern. Fold the straight edge down, then gather and tack with a running stitch. Pull the thread to gather the folds and tie them together. Glue the veil to the carton.

6 Bride to be

Make a crown out of two pipe cleaners and decorate it with pom-poms or any other material you like. Glue the crown over the veil to complete your Bride's look. Once finished you have your very own recycled friend.
