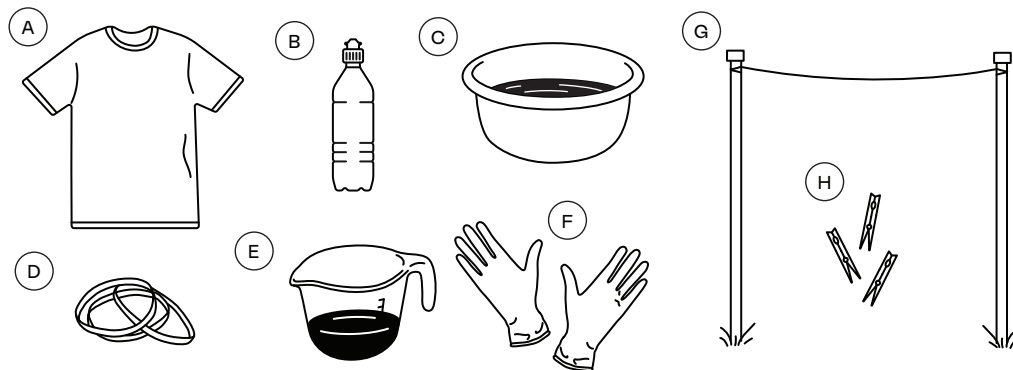


This is Art Club! Tie Dye T-shirt

What you'll need!

- A. T-shirt
- B. Plastic Bottles
- C. Water & Basin
- D. Rubber Bands
- E. Jug with Natural Dye
- F. Rubber Gloves
- G. Clothes Line
- H. Clothes Pegs



A few simple steps Tie Dye T-shirt



1 Soak your t-shirt

Fill your basin with water and leave your t-shirt to soak until there are no dry patches.

2 Get twisting

Squeeze all the water out and lay your t-shirt out flat. Pinch the centre of your t-shirt and twist it into a circular shape.

3 Wrap it up

Wrap at least 3 rubber bands around your t-shirt to secure the shape.

4 Fill up your bottles

Natural dyes can be created from many different objects such as vegetables, seaweed, flowers and even insects!

Pick three different colours you made from the natural dyes (or food colouring) and place them into the plastic bottles. Don't forget to put on your gloves to protect your hands!

5 Add dye drops

Have fun splashing different colours onto your t-shirt. Repeat the fun on the opposite side.

6 Dry & wait eagerly

Take off the rubber bands to reveal your fabulous pattern. Then leave your t-shirt to dry on a clothes line. Boom! You have your very own groovy tie dye t-shirt!!!
